This will include how to talk about incidents respectfully, engage young people in being accountable, increase awareness of the implications of their choices, and heighten their ability to engage in more constructive perspectives.

Cutting edge ideas around externalizing problems, examining patterns of interactions, creating brain maps, and engaging groups in becoming secret success spies will be discussed.
